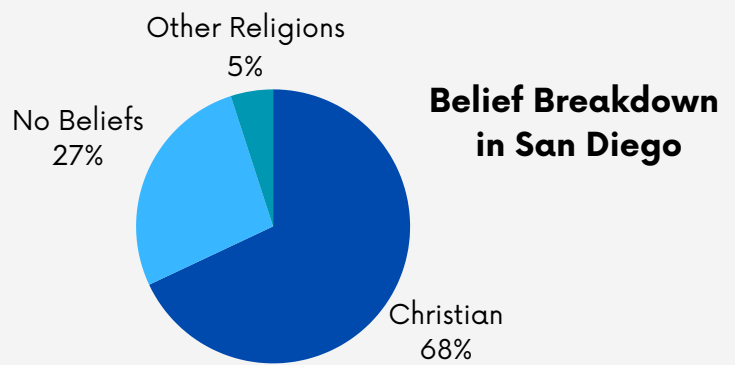
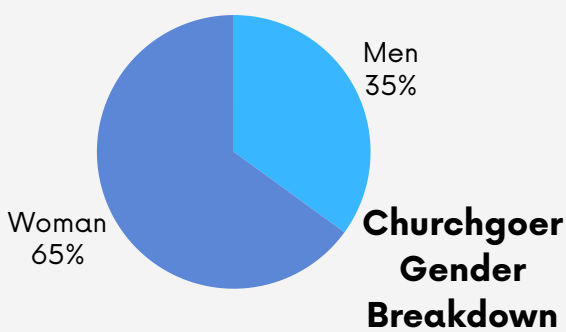
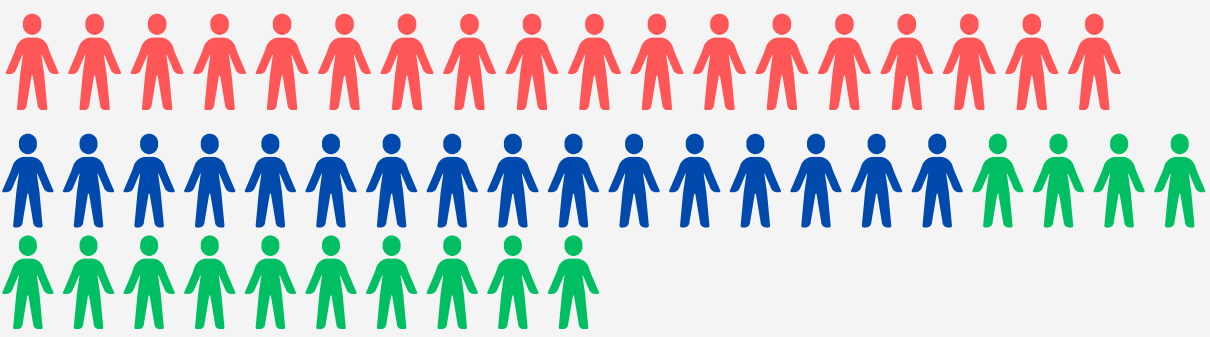
## A BREAKDOWN OF SAN DIEGO'S CHURCH CULTURE AND ATTENDANCE

### PRC

According to the Pew Research Center 68% of Adults in San Diego consider themselves Christian.

### PRC

Out of that number, 31% say they attend a Church service at least once a week, 36% say they attend once or twice a month and 33% say they almost never attend.



### MEGACHURCH

## ATTENDANCE COMPARISON

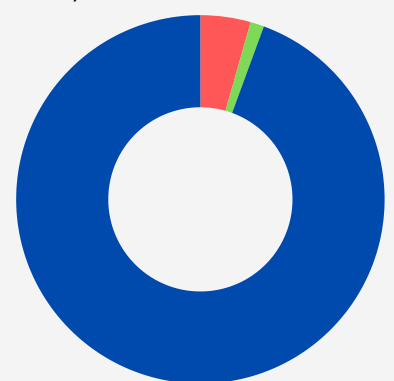
The average sized church seats anywhere from 50-200 people while The Rock and Awaken can take up a combined 22,000 per week with their multiple locations

This equates to just over 5% of San Diego's entire weekly church attendance which doesn't seem like a lot, until you consider how many other churches are in San Diego.

1 in every 20 people that attend church in San Diego attend one of these two megachurches. As far as the other 19, your odds of guessing where they attend would be 1 in 1,183
